## I AM the Resurrection

Scripture: John 11:25–26; John 20:1–18

### 1: Resurrection Is Not an Event — It Is a Person

- Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ life before He performs it (speaks)
- God's delay is not His \_\_\_\_\_ (denial)
- Resurrection power works in \_\_\_\_\_ places (dead)

### 2: The Resurrection Rewrites My Identity

- The empty tomb cancels my old \_\_\_\_\_ (label)
- What died with Christ cannot \_\_\_\_\_ me (define)
- Resurrection gives me a new "I \_\_\_\_\_" (AM)

### 3: My Words Must Agree With the Resurrection

- \_\_\_\_\_ language contradicts resurrection power (death)
- Faith speaks \_\_\_\_\_ over feelings (truth)
- \_\_\_\_\_ reinforces identity (confession)
